

**Environmental Policy** 

The St Margaret's Hope Pier Trustees endeavor to minimize environmental pollution, as a result of their own activities and of others who use their services. The Trustees review their policies and services on a regular basis to ensure the maintenance of the highest possible environmental standards.

The Trustees fully recognise the requirements of a Harbour Authority under the Nature Conservation Act (Scotland) Act 2004 to further the conservation of biodiversity within the statutory harbour area.

To that end, the Trustees have produced an Oil Pollution Contingency Plan, approved by the Maritime and Coastguard Agency. This Plan has the agreement of SEPA, Marine Scotland, SNH and Orkney Marine Services, with whom the Trustees have an arrangement for dealing with major spillages.

A Port Waste Management Plan, approved by the Maritime and Coastguard Agency and detailed in this manual, has also been produced. Monitoring of the local environment is carried out by Trustee employees, and an ongoing dialogue is in place with local organisations on which environmental change would have major impact, e.g. salmon farms, Orkney Seal Rescue and RSPB.
