Introduction

Second-hand smoking, breathing in other people's tobacco smoke, has been shown to cause cancers, heart and respiratory disease in non-smokers. Section 2 (2)(e) of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 places a duty on employers to provide a working environment for employees that is:

"Safe, without risk to health, and adequate with regards to facilities and arrangements for their welfare at work."

St Margaret's Hope Pier Trustees acknowledge that second-hand tobacco smoke is both a public and work place health hazard and have therefore adopted this no-smoking policy.

The policy seeks to:

- Guarantee a healthy working environment and protect the current and future health of employees, customers and visitors
- Guarantee the right of non-smokers to breathe in air free from tobacco smoke
- To comply with Heath and Safety Legislation and Employment Law
- Raise awareness of the dangers associated with exposure to tobacco smoke
